

Wind Tre: recognition from the Czech Republic for best practices on 5G

Awarded by the Ministry of Industry and Trade during the "5G FOR 5 CITIES" The Ministry of Industry and Trade of the Czech Republic has awarded Wind Tre, a company led by Jeffrey Hedberg, a prestigious recognition for the "close cooperation and best practice sharing for the development of 5G". Sabina Strazzullo, Director of Institutional Affairs of Wind Tre, received the award during the "5G FOR 5 CITIES" ceremony, held in Prague for the assignment of the 5G trial to the cities of the Czech Republic, in the presence of the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Industry and Commerce, Karel Havlíček, the Deputy Minister for Digitalization and Innovation, Petr Očko, the Minister of Regional Development, Klára Dostálová and the Deputy Prime Minister of Regional Development, David Koppitz.
