Montebelluna, 13 March 2024 – WINDTRE BUSINESS and the Municipality of Montebelluna have launched an innovative agreement for the creation of training courses in STEM subjects. In fact, teachers and students at the ITS Einaudi Scarpa institute will be involved in an unprecedented teaching model that focuses on Cyber Security, Big Data Analytics, and Robotics. This marks the first time that specific courses of study within the secondary education institution will focus on these particular subjects.

Thanks to the calls for bids announced within the context of the Scuola 4.0 NRRP, the ITS Einaudi Scarpa institute was able to acquire specific training courses from WINDTRE BUSINESS on Ethical Hacking, Secure Coding, OSINT, Threat Intelligence, Incident Response, Digital Forensics, and Malware Analysis. In addition, highly innovative robots have been provided for the training courses in the fields of robotics and programming. Big Data Analytics services will also be available, thus enabling students to learn how the knowledge and study of data can be useful for planning and optimising services throughout the country.

This initiative was made possible thanks to the institute's partnership with WINDTRE BUSINESS, which provided the know-how needed to launch the specific training programmes for the students. The aim of these new projects is to develop knowledge in areas of technological innovation among students attending high schools and technical institutes, providing them with skills that will be indispensable for the professions of the future.
