6) APPROACH

Wind Tre is committed to actively contributing to the protection of the planet and enhancing people's quality of life by driving a fair and environmentally sustainable transition through its technologies.

To this end, the Company is dedicated to mitigate the negative environmental impacts of its daily activities and empowering its customers and stakeholders to do the same by adopting appropriate behaviour and using innovative technologies, processes, and systems.

In particular, the company undertakes to:

- give particular importance to the application of all national, EU and international environmental laws and regulations.
- periodically define commitments to improve its environmental performance, especially regarding issues that are considered relevant by the company and its stakeholders.
- implement process and procedures for all the activities to manage and reduce its environmental impacts also through environmental management systems and certification.
- report periodically on the company's environmental impact and performance through its corporate website and the publication of a Sustainability Report.
- promote and raise awareness of environmental issues among employees also through internal communication and training.

Fighting Climate Change

- Wind Tre focuses its efforts on reducing CO₂ emissions across its operations, facilities, and services, recognising this as crucial in the fight against climate change.
- Wind Tre analyses its Scope 1, 2, and 3 emissions to identify sources and assess their intensity, enabling the development of strategies to reduce their impact and share this data with stakeholders.
 The company also certifies its carbon footprint according to the international ISO 14064 standard, with the goal of continually enhancing its analyses and improvement efforts.
- Wind Tre is committed to using innovative and efficient technologies to continuously reduce its
 environmental impact. By way of example but not limited to, the company is committed to periodically
 modernising its national transmission network so that it is increasingly energy efficient, increasing the
 number of low environmental impact vehicles in the company car fleet, and adopting methods capable
 of reducing employees' environmental impact, such as working remotely and reducing business travel.
- Wind Tre recognises the need to increase the use of renewable energies as much as possible as an
 essential tool to combat climate-changing gas emissions and works to continuously improve its energy
 mix.
- Wind Tre has introduced the risk of climate change into its Enterprise Risk Management (ERM) register, and this risk is included in the assessment and evaluation activities conducted on a semi-annual basis.

Protecting Natural Resources and Biodiversity

- Wind Tre supports the protection of nature and biodiversity, also through collaboration with associations
 and third sector organisations. The company recognises and promotes the sustainable use of natural
 resources and the protection, conservation and restoration of biodiversity, and also supports the fight
 against deforestation.
- The company works to continuously improve its internal procedures and processes in order to increase efficiency and reduce the consumption of day-to-day operational products such as paper, electronic equipment and the like, and to improve the sustainability of the working environment, e.g. through automatic on/off light systems and smart office sharing.
- Wind Tre recognises the importance of ongoing waste reduction, which includes recycling and reusing materials. The company actively pursues initiatives such as reducing plastic usage in offices and shops.
- Wind Tre recognizes the importance of water conservation sensitising its supply chain to adopt measures to protect against environmental pollution and promote water efficiency.

Promoting Circular Economy

- Aligned with the Group's guidelines and with the active involvement of suppliers and partners, Wind Tre
 promotes the integration of circular economy principles into its value chain. This includes responsible
 sourcing of raw materials, optimising production processes and product design, minimizing waste,
 reducing pollution risks, and raising awareness of sustainable practices among consumers and
 employees.
- The company promotes the use of materials and tools consistent with the circularity of resources, such
 as recycled paper and recyclable toners, and promotes circular economy initiatives aimed at ensuring
 the reduction and reuse of electronic waste (WEEE).

- Wind Tre promotes the continuous improvement of the environmental impacts of its supply chain also
 through an appropriate management of the procurement process. Suppliers handled by Wind Tre
 Procurement's department adhere to the principles of this policy, also present in the Wind Tre'
 Sustainable Procurement Policy, and undertake to integrate the principles of environmental
 sustainability also within their own supply chain.
- Wind Tre undertakes to make the communities in which it operates aware of the importance of environmental conservation and to promote best practices that improve environmental sustainability, also through collaboration with third sector organisations and with central and local institutions.
- Wind Tre intends to drive the Twin Transition—both digital and sustainable—by its own investment in 5G and digital technologies. Digitalisation has the potential to significantly reduce greenhouse gas emissions across various sectors, minimise waste, optimise resource use, support the adoption of circular economy models, improve land management, and aid in climate change adaptation.
- Wind Tre aims to help businesses and consumers enhance the environmental sustainability and
 efficiency of their activities, as well as improve the quality of work and life, through innovative solutions
 developed in collaboration with commercial and technological partners. Additionally, it seeks to assist
 local governments in transforming their municipalities into smart, environmentally sustainable cities.

Fighting Climate Change

The company is committed to minimising its environmental impact, focusing on reducing greenhouse gas emissions, which is a critical factor in combating climate change, and striving for a more efficient resource use.

To this end, Wind Tre has defined specific targets to reduce and mitigate its impact on greenhouse gas emissions:

- Wind Tre has defined a plan for reducing to zero its emissions (CO₂ equivalent) for Scope 1 and 2 to be realized by 2030 and, in line with the parent company's guidelines, has implemented the goal of achieving climate neutrality by 2050.
- In accordance with the parent company's guidelines, Wind Tre has implemented the target of reducing indirect climate-changing emissions (CO₂ equivalents) generated upstream and downstream of its value chain (Scope 3 emissions) by 42% by 2030.
- Wind Tre makes its suppliers aware of environmental issues through the indications contained in this Policy, the ESG Policy, the Sustainable Procurement Policy and the Supplier Code of Conduct and promotes their commitment to improving their own environmental performance.
- Wind Tre is committed to reducing the emissions generated by its company car fleet through the progressive inclusion of new vehicles with low CO₂ emissions.
